SUMMARY OF POSITION:

The School Council wishes to hire an English Language Arts teacher to support Indigenous adult learners.

The position's main responsibility is to teach reading, composition, oral and comprehension skills in an adult education center. Other secondary studies subjects, such as Math or History, may be required.

All, as prescribed by the Quebec Education Act and the policies in effect at the First Nations Adult Education School Council (FNAESC). The FNAESC, created by the First Nations Human Resources Development Commission of Québec, currently supports four regional adult education centers and three satellite centers.

ESSENTIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- A teaching licence or permit (completed or in progress);
- Ability to manage a multi-level and multi-subject classroom;
- Ability to support adult learners in attaining their educational objectives in a safe learning environment.
- Ability to work collaboratively and offer cross-curricular programming;
- Culturally proficient.

ASSETS:

- Knowledge of an Indigenous language*;
- Knowledge of Indigenous cultures and Indigenous organizations in Quebec, as well as the socio-economic issues within the communities;
- Knowledge of the new curriculum changes in the Quebec education system;
- Experience working in adult education;
- Knowledge of the realities of Kanien'kehá:ka communities.

Candidates selected for an interview will be required to provide a recent police background check.

Only qualified candidates, with the required background and experience, will be called for an interview. In the absence of fully qualified candidates, the selection committee reserves the right to interview candidates with pertinent experience for the position.

*All things being equal, priority will be given to candidates who speak an Indigenous language.
