



Programme Logement abordable durable

Projects:

Retrofit – 25% or more reduction in energy consumption



New construction – Energy consumption near Net zero (80 kWh/m2 , 120 kWh/m2 for the North)



Affordability – 30% of building units equal or are less than 80% of median rent



To support projects that will promote innovation, education, and knowledge transfer in the community housing sector.





Launched in 2022 by the Centre, Plancher is an initiative from Quebec's **social and community housing sector**.

The associated consultation process involved more than 200 organizations, united around a **common goal**:


To implement an impactful project enabling the community housing sector to respond to the housing crisis.


