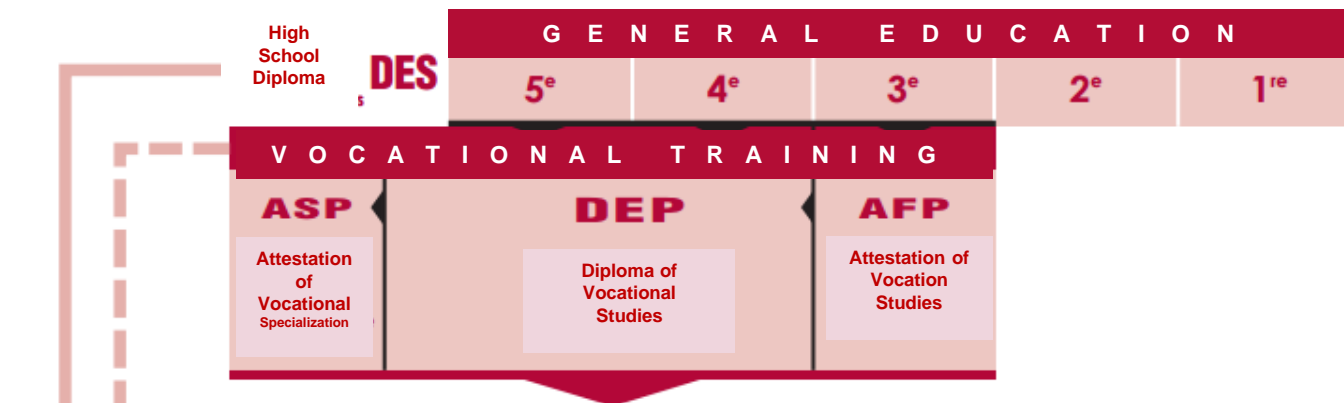


The Québec Education System

TOTAL OF 54 CREDITS



The DES (High School Diploma):

- 54 credits (in AGE or AGE+ VT)
- Mandatory credits:
 - Secondary IV: language of instruction (6)
second language (6)
mathematics (6)
 - Secondary IV/V: sciences or computers (4)
history or social sciences (4)
 - Secondary V: language of instruction (6)
second language (6)

+ 18 optional credits

(20 of 54 credits MUST be from Secondary V)



OTHER SECONDARY TRAINING

Attestation of Secondary Studies

- Sociovocational Integration
 - Personal profile (entrance and exit)
 - Work force
- Semi-specialized trades (aids, clerks, attendants, assistants, cleaners, auxiliaries)
 - Personal profile (entrance and exit)
 - Basic courses – languages and mathematics
 - Competency development courses and orientation
 - Internships



EQUIVALENCIES OR RECOGNITION OF ACQUIRED COMPETENCIES (R.A.C.)

GENERAL DEVELOPMENT TEST (G.D.T.)

- Duration: 3 hours
- 100 questions (language of instruction, general knowledge in sciences, social sciences, mathematics and problem solving)
- Passing grade (43/100)
- No retakes
- Level: end of Secondary III
- Partial access to certain vocational training programs
- Access to the work force



SECONDARY V EQUIVALENCIES

Attestation of Secondary Studies (A.E.S.S.)

- 5 exams, 90 minutes each
- Mandatory: language of instruction (2 exams)
- second language
- Choice of 2 of the following:
 - mathematics
 - social sciences
 - sciences
 - economics

Passing grade: 60% on each test

Right to 3 retakes for each exam

Maximum time: 6 months

ACCESS TO CERTAIN A.E.C.

RETURN TO SECONDARY STUDIES



G.E.D. (GENERAL EDUCATION DIPLOMA)

- Equivalency recognized in North America and certain other countries
- Equivalent to secondary VI, or grade 12
- 7 exams required, over 2 predetermined days
- One retake within 12 months
- Passing grade: 60% on each exam (external corrections)
- Very strict guidelines
- Evaluation test and registration 3 to 6 months in advance
- Prep courses recommended
- Limited access



In-person studies

1 credit = 25 hours

Distance education

6 months to complete

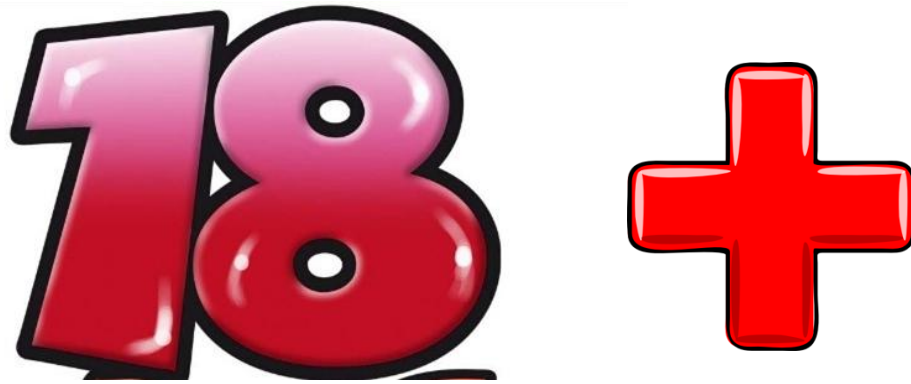

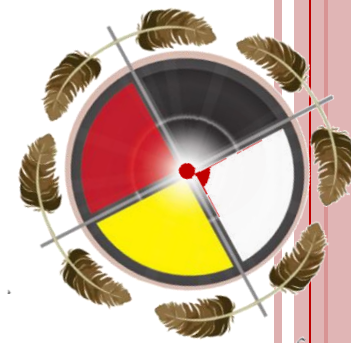
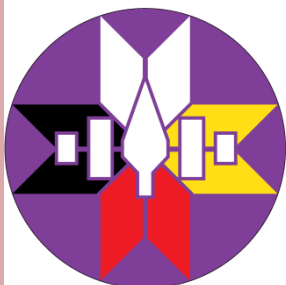
